First Presbyterian Church of Victor Audio & Visual System



We have a proposal for an audio and visual system for our worship experience. It will be used to display: video and text announcements before and after the service, images of mission & community events, inspired art & photographs, biblical & service text, witness experiences, displaying song lyrics and playing recorded music.

The system can also be used to record audio and be expanded to video record the service. The new video system includes ~100" screen, short throw projector, HD hardware, 32" screen for the choir and pastor, and an internet connected laptop computer.

The improved audio system will use a linear speaker array, amplifiers, and new processor to provide a more uniform and clear sound for the entire sanctuary.

The system cost of about \$18,500 will include the hardware, installation and system instructions. Our fundraising effort will begin in the spring of 2019 and installation will occur when we have raised the needed funds.
