Scripture Reading

Genesis 1:1-2:4, selected verses; **Response in bold**

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was a formless void and darkness covered the face of the deep, while a wind from God swept over the face of the waters. (cont,)

Scripture Reading (cont.)

God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. And God saw that the light was good; and God separated the light from the darkness. God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, the first day.

And God said, "Let there be a dome in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters." And it was so. God called the dome Sky. And there was evening and there was morning, the second day.

And God said, "Let the waters under the sky be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear." **And it was so.** God called the dry land Earth, and the waters that were gathered together he called Seas. **And God saw that it was good.**

Then God said, "Let the earth put forth vegetation. And it was so. And God saw that it was good. And there was evening and there was morning, the third day.

And God said, "Let there be lights in the dome of the sky to separate the day from the night and let them be lights in the dome of the sky to give light upon the earth." **And it was so.** God made the two great lights--the greater light to rule the day and the lesser light to rule the night--and the stars. And **God saw that it was good. And there was evening and there was morning, the fourth day.**

And God said, "Let the waters bring forth swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the dome of the sky." So God created the great sea monsters and every living creature that moves, of every kind. **And God saw that it was good.** God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth." **And there was evening and there was morning, the fifth day. And it was so.** God made the wild animals of the earth, the cattle and everything that creeps on the ground of every kind. **And God saw that it was good.**

Then God said, "Let us make humankind in our image, according to our likeness." So God created humankind in his image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth and subdue it; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, and every living thing that moves upon the earth." God said, "See, I have given everything that has the breath of life every green plant for food." **And it was so.** (cont.)

Scripture Reading (cont.)

God saw everything that he had made, and indeed, **it was very good**. **And there was evening and there was morning, the sixth day**. Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all their multitude.

And on the seventh day God finished the work, and rested on the seventh day from all the work. So God blessed the seventh day and hallowed it, because on it God rested from all the work that he had done in creation.
