<u>The 5 Love Languages</u> by Gary Chapman. This book articulates the different ways people are most able to feel loved and possibilities for those who love to do so with intention.

The 5 Love Languages are:

- 1. Words of Affirmation
- 2. Quality Time
- 3. Receiving Gifts
- 4. Acts of Service
- 5. Physical Touch

We are a people who, at our best, identify as those who love and follow Jesus the Christ. We also live in a culture that will make a very big deal about Valentine's Day, a day to express our love to someone special. What if we made a faith choice to combine the two this year?

Look at the list above and ask yourself which way is your most effective way of receiving love. Once you have identified your favorite imagine for a moment how you could offer that to Jesus and your faith community.

If you are moved by words of affirmation, then share your faith in praise of the Holy and thank a sister and brother for their good gifts in this place.

If you are moved by quality time, then set aside some time to settle in prayer and take a sister or brother out to lunch just to be with them in fellowship.

If you love receiving thoughtful gifts, then make a special gift to the ministry of your community and surprise a friend with a token you know they will appreciate.

If you feel loved by being cared for in service, then sign up for Family Promise or a Community Dinner and help a sister or brother out.

If you are assured of loved by positive touch, then sit with a sister or brother in distress and ask to hold their hand, exchange a sign of the Peace of Christ, hug your parents, your friends, your kids, and your dog. If your cat will let you, do that too.

What you have been given can be shared. You are loved by God through the gift of the Christ. Go now and love the children of the Lord.
